2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLTON, CALIFORNIA,  
3 APPROVING ADDITION OF A STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT THROUGH A  
4 MODIFICATION TO THE CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
5 BLOCK GRANT FUNDS

7 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Colton elected to enter into a Cooperation  
8 Agreement with the County of San Bernardino in order to receive Community Development  
9 Block Grant ("CDBG") funds; and

10 WHEREAS, as a "Cooperating City," the City of Colton receives annual funding  
11 allocations of CDBG funds; and

12 WHEREAS, twice each year, the County of San Bernardino allows projects to be  
13 submitted as amendments to the Consolidated Plan ("Plan Mod"); and

14  
15 WHEREAS, the City Council seated a committee, known as the CDBG Ad Hoc  
16 Committee ("Committee"), comprised of three (3) City Council members and three (3)  
17 Planning Commissioners, to review the eligible projects and make funding recommendations  
18 to the Council; and

20 WHEREAS, the Committee has recommended the use of unspent project funds for an  
21 alleyway and sidewalk curb ramp improvement project and the construction of a community  
22 garden as a Plan Mod Project; and

23 WHEREAS, the City Council, as the governing body of the City of Colton, is required by  
24 statute to take a formal action approving projects to be recommended to the County for  
25 funding with CDBG funds in their Consolidated Plan to comply with CDBG program  
26 regulations and subject to available funding.

2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Colton, as  
3 follows:

4 SECTION 1. The recitals preceding this Resolution are true and correct and are  
5 incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.  
6

7 SECTION 2. The City Council is recommending the alleyway, sidewalk and community  
8 garden project to utilize City unspent CDBG funds.


9 SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Colton has determined that the  
10 recommendation in this Resolution is categorically exempt from environmental review  
11 pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, sections 21000,  
12 *et seq.*). The project is for the replacement and reconstruction of existing alleyway and  
13 sidewalk curb ramps as described in section 15301(c) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14  
14 California Code of Regulations sections 15000, *et seq.*) and will result in no expansion of an  
15 existing use. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to file all appropriate notices pursuant  
16 to CEQA with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino,  
17 California.

20 SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution. This  
21 Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
