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**RESOLUTION NO. R-78-15**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLTON, CALIFORNIA, TO APPROVE SERVICE AND NONDISCLOSURE INTER-UTILITY AGREEMENT BETWEEN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY (SOCAL GAS) AND COLTON ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT (CED)**

**WHEREAS**, It is recommended that the City Council approve entering into a service and non-disclosure inter-utility agreement between SoCal Gas Company and CED for an income qualified energy efficiency mobile home retrofit program and authorize the City manager to execute the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, SoCal Gas Company enters into an agreements pursuant to Division 11 of the California State Water Code to establish working relationships between other utilities to share certain customer information in order to better serve the needs of low income customers within SoCal Gas Company's service territories. SoCal Gas Company manages the delivery of its Energy Savings Assistance Program (ESAP); and

**WHEREAS**, CED would reimburse SoCal Gas Company for services provided by SoCal Gas to income qualified residential customers in the service territory of CED. CED would be able to claim energy and water savings from this partnership while providing a valuable service to mobile home owners in need of EE retrofits; and

**WHEREAS**, California Assembly Bill 1890 requires municipal electric utilities to collect revenues for the following Public Benefit Programs:

Cost effective demand side management services to promote energy efficiency and energy conservation; (2) new investments in renewable energy resources and technologies consistent with existing statutes and regulations which promote those resources and technologies; (3) research, development and demonstration programs for the public interest to advance science or technology which is not adequately provided by competitive and regulated markets; (4) services provided for low income electricity customers, including but not limited to, targeted energy efficiency services and rate discounts; and

**WHEREAS**, In 2005, the California Legislature passed Senate Bill (SB) 1037 requiring publicly owned utilities (POU) to report kilowatt (kWh) savings to the California Energy Commission (CEC) annually. In 2006, Assembly Bill (AB) 2021 was approved requiring publicly owned electric utilities to identify, target and achieve all potentially cost-effective electricity savings. In February of 2015 AB 1330 was passed requiring CED to establish an EE resource standard that would increase the amount of EE resources of the utility so that the total amount of incremental energy savings achieved in any given year amounts to not less than specified amounts. The Colton Electric Department (CED) currently offers a wide variety of residential and commercial energy efficiency rebate programs in an effort to achieve the mandated goals of AB 2021. Staff recommends that by entering into an inter-utility agreement with SoCal Gas Company, CED will be able to achieve the kWh savings to meet an EE goal

1 equivalent to 1% of retail sales and claim water savings to meet the state's water reduction  
2 mandate of 25%; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Funds for this program were approved in the Fiscal Year Budget for CED  
4 through the Public Benefits Program charge in the following account 526-8000-8035-2350-  
0923-000; and

5 **NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Colton does hereby resolve the  
6 following:

7 **Section 1.** This City Council finds and declares approve entering into a service and non-  
8 disclosure inter-utility agreement between SoCal Gas Company and CED for an income  
qualified energy efficiency mobile home retrofit program.


9 **Section 2.** This City Council finds and declares the City manager to execute the
