

An Ordinance of the City of Colton Closing and vacating certain streets and alleys in the City of Colton.

The Board of trustees of the City of Colton do ordain as follows:

Section. I. That the certain alley in the Block 122 of the City of Colton beginning at fifth street and extending easterly to a point in said alley heretofore closed and vacated. is hereby vacated and closed.

Section 2, That second street in the City of Colton from the south property line of the right of way of the Southern Pacific railroad company to the south line of M street, excepting therefrom the intersections of K, and L, street is hereby vacated and closed.

Section 3, That N O street from the west side of the right of way of the meeks and Daly ditch westerly to the City limits is hereby closed and vacated;

That all, of the said streets and alleys are according to the official map of the town of Colton as per plat of record in book nine of maps at page thirtyseven, records of san bernardino county, this ordinance is in pursuance to the resolution of intention heretofore adopted in the matter of the closing of said streets and alleys and pursuant to the notice of the public work hereintofore posted along the line of said streets and alleys herein closed.


